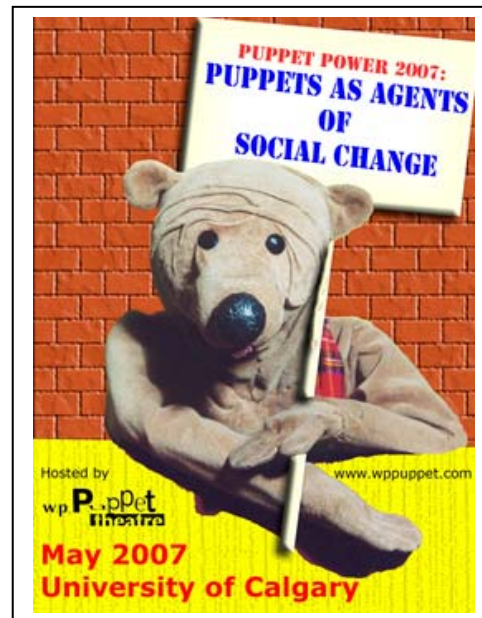

PARKING INFORMATION FOR VARIOUS CONFERENCE SITES:

EPCOR CENTRE for the Performing Arts 205 8th Avenue S.E.

The EPCOR CENTRE is located two blocks east of the Calgary Tower on the north side of 9th Avenue.

Underground parking is available at the EPCOR CENTRE, situated at 829 Macleod Trail SE. The entrance is between 9th & 8th Avenues. For those traveling northbound on Macleod Trail, access to the parkade is a left-turn immediately after crossing 9th Avenue. For those traveling eastbound on 9th Avenue, access to the parkade will be from the left turning lane at Macleod Trail North, and then another left almost immediately again once on Macleod Trail North. Please note that the parkade is closed and locked at midnight.

Hourly & daily rates include GST; Monthly rates do not. In cases of discrepancy between rates shown on this site and rates posted at the lot, the rates posted at the lot are taken as correct.

Daytime Mon-Fri (07:00 - 18:00)

\$2.00 per ½hr or portion, to MAX of \$13.00

Daytime Sat, Sun & Holidays (08:30 – 18:00)

\$5.00 pre-pay flat

Evenings everyday (18:00 – 07:00)

\$5.00 pre-pay flat

Other options include:

1. Civic Plaza parkade located at 322 - 9th Avenue SE.
2. TELUS Convention Centre parkade situated off 1st Street SE between 7th & 8th Avenue.
3. Palliser Square, located on the south side in the 100 block on 9th Avenue SW. Access to the EPCOR CENTRE is via the Plus 15 network. (Please note that parking fees and hours are subject to change. For details call (403) 537-7000 or go to www.calgaryparking.com)
4. Open air parking lots in the 200, 300 and 400 blocks on the south side of 9th Avenue SE. The cost is \$1.50 per 1/2 hour daily until 6:00 PM (daily max charge is \$9.00.) From 6:00 PM to 6 AM these lots charge a flat rate of \$5. [Click here](#) for more information.
5. (Please note that on-the-street parking meters are also available and are free evenings after 6 PM and on Sundays.)

To use public transportation, the C-Train LRT runs along 7th Ave, one block north of the CENTRE. If going eastbound, get off at either Centre Street Station or City Hall Station. If going westbound, get off at Olympic Plaza Station. Call (403) 262-1000 for more information and fares.
